System SEVEN Workgroup Edition™ provides real-time remote access to corporate email, calendar, and personal and corporate contacts, enabling access for up to 25 users within small businesses, or departments within larger organisations. It can also serve as a trial tool for enterprises who would like users to experience and enjoy the benefits of push email, giving them access to key information anytime, anywhere.

It is a secure, low cost solution for small businesses, as software is installed and managed via one desktop application. With no need for professional IT expertise or permissions to be granted, it is very quick and easy to deploy. It is also the ideal up-sell solution for enterprises who wish to deploy System SEVEN Enterprise Edition™.

The new System SEVEN software has been designed to allow a single application to be installed. By simplifying its use and as well as addressing the needs of multiple market segments, it will increase adoption across all editions. Compatible with over 240 mobile devices covering all device operating systems including Symbian, PalmOS, J2ME, Windows Mobile and BREW, you can leverage existing device investments and choice, making it a very flexible and affordable mobile email solution.

The software has been upgraded to provide multi-inbox support, integrating personal and business inboxes. Used together with System SEVEN Consumer Edition™, you can have access to multiple personal email accounts, with the option of having several devices provisioned to the same account.

EASY END-USER PROVISIONING

System SEVEN Workgroup Edition™ can now be provisioned simply by the end-user, without the need for expensive face-to-face installation support. Users can sign-up for the service either by downloading and installing the Workgroup Connector via the web and having the download links sent to the device by SMS.

Alternatively, the user can install from the device either by using a GetMail application which has been pre-installed by the mobile operator or device manufacturer or by clicking on the download link embedded within a welcome email sent to the user. If the device has been pre-provisioned, only your password is required to activate the service.

NEW AND ENHANCED KEY FEATURES

The software delivers a compelling end-user experience with automatic updates through real-time push email technology. It provides a full suite of desktop-like functions – these include two-way synchronisation of read/unread and deleted emails and selecting inbox subfolders to be synchronised to the phone. The end-user has the ability to see enhanced attachment features, create a signature file to be added to all messages and indicate priority flags; as well as to click on hyperlinks for phone numbers, URLs, and email addresses directly from the message.

Users can browse and search for contacts from multiple sources such as the local address book and global address list. Access to calendar data is also available on the device with updates pushed over-the-air. Users can create, edit and delete meetings and appointments as well as change the accept/decline status of a meeting. Meeting reminders are presented with visual and sound indicators provided by the native calendar functionality and future events are automatically synced to the device.

To save costs and ensure longer battery life, the end-user can put it in stand-by mode if roaming or set it to automatically go into pause mode if the battery is low. Upgrades to new versions of software can take place over-the air for easy life-cycle management.
